Test results are fully audited by AFL technical services staff. Results must comply with the CSG requirements and AS/NZS ISO/IEC 14763.3.

AFL can then issue the CSG subject to completion and compliance with the CSG documentation.

State of the art test and measurement equipment is used to verify the quality and performance of the products that will be the backbone of your communications network.

Terms and Conditions

Certified System Guarantee (CSG) – 20 Years

Approval Conditions:

1. Applicable to standards based links and channels only.
2. Applies to CSG approved products only. Non approved products include: mechanical splices and connectors used outdoors, underground splice/patch enclosures, metal enclosures installed outdoors, aerial cables, direct buried underground cables, tight buffered cables installed externally, copper cables installed externally, deployable cable systems, directly terminated connectors, products attached to moving components or machinery.
3. AFL approved partners to be engaged for installation, termination and testing.
4. AFL approved partners are to comply with all CSG installation and testing requirements.
5. Products are to be installed and tested to all relevant standards including: AS/NZS 3080, AS/ACIF S009, AS3000, AS/NZS ISO/IEC 14763.3, and TIA-568.

AFL guarantees that during a period of twenty (20) years from the date of certification, the approved cabling products supplied and installed will convey voice, data or video signal protocols for which the system was designed. AFL certified systems, or portions thereof, will perform to the specifications of AS/NZS 3080, TIA/EIA 568/569, AS/NZS ISO/IEC 14763.3 and ISO/IEC 11801.

In the event that the certified system does not convey the required signal to which the system was designed during this guaranteed period, AFL will diagnose the problem, replace or repair products, at its sole option, these portions of the system necessary to convey such signals. In these circumstances AFL will provide all testing, inspection, and replacement products where required, to make the system operable. The AFL Installer named on the guarantee will warrant and provide any installation or repair required to meet these approved standards.

For purposes of this guarantee an 'AFL Group Certified System Guarantee' is a complete certified AFL approved installation. This guarantee is non-transferable and applies only to the approved certified system. Any modification to the approved AFL certified system without AFL's written authorisation voids this guarantee. AFL reserves the right to refuse a certification of a system which it deems incorrect in design or installation.

AFL will also provide a 20 year material and workmanship defects warranty on all AFL products used in an AFL approved certified system. Under this warranty AFL will in its sole option either repair or replace any such AFL products used in the approved system, which in the judgment of AFL is shown to be defective in material or workmanship during the guarantee period.

This warranty is extended only to the AFL products which are defective in material or workmanship through no fault of the dealer or the end user and which have not been subjected to; including but not limited to; improper use, damage, rodent/insect attack, unauthorised maintenance, unauthorised repair or rework, cleaning, handling, storage, sabotage, environmental conditions (temperature outside normal operating ranges, high/low temperature cycling, high humidity), chemical/substance attack (marine salt, air borne contaminants, corrosion, oxidization, acidic or caustic substances, petroleum based products), EMI (electromagnetic interference), RFI (radio frequency interference), fire, flood, unauthorised moves, additions or changes, relocation to another site.

AFL expressly excludes all other warranties, expressed or implied, including without limitation the implied warranties or merchantability and fitness for any particular purpose. AFL expressly excludes all liabilities for consequential and incidental damages including but not limited to the lost profits arising from design, sale, or use of its products, even if AFL has been advised of the possibility of such damages in advance. AFL's liability hereunder in any case is expressly limited to replacement of products only complying with or listed within this warranty. In no event shall AFL be liable for loss of profits or incident, indirect or other consequential damages.

This guarantee is not transferable and applies only to AFL certified site guarantee approved products, installed, tested and inspected as defined in the CSG guidelines.
